THE FIRST NERCT SERIES EVENT 2021 "Between Fear, Bias and Reality", April 7th

The first NERCT series event this year is scheduled online for Wednesday 7th April, 2021, 3:30pm (Lagos), 4:30pm (CET). The event will discuss pandemic disinformation and how it impacts the vaccination campaign in Nigeria. The theme "Between Fear, Bias and Reality" covers scientific breakthroughs on COVID-19 vaccines as well as governmental strategies to communicate total and partial lockdowns to their citizens.

Before the global spread of the COVID-19 pandemic, nations like Nigeria were already challenged by terrorism, organised crime and corruption. These security problems have now become exacerbated by additional weaknesses in the healthcare system and spreading disinformation.

Her public health law work has included regulatory support for Nigeria during COVID-19, in-depth assessment of Nigeria's legal framework for public health and support for legislative development and law reform.
